



MCHL Parent Guidelines for Covid-19 August 2022

- Parents and visitors will be required to wear a mask when entering the building.
- Masks are optional for children and staff.
- Children will be required to sanitize their hands upon entering the building with adult supervision.
- Children with a fever of 100.4° or above will be sent home and may return to MCHL 24 hours after they are symptom free.
- MCHL will provide a separate “isolation” room for children who exhibit any symptoms of Covid-19, and they will remain in that room until they are picked up.
- Any illness in your family should be reported to MCHL immediately.
- If your child tests positive for Covid, please keep him/her home for 5 days after the positive diagnosis. Your child may return to school when he/she is symptom free and will be required to wear a mask in school for an additional 5 days. If your child is not able to wear a mask or under the age of two, please keep him/her at home for 10 days.
- If your child is coughing, we reserve the right to place a mask on your child if he/she is two years old and above.
- If there is a case of Covid-19 in your child’s classroom, we will notify all the parents in the class via email. The classroom will remain open. Please watch your child for any symptoms.
- If someone in your household has tested positive for Covid-19, please keep your child home for 5 days and watch for symptoms.
