CASCADES CLUB UPDATE



If your child is staying beyond 3:00 and you would like sunscreen applied, please stop by the office to complete an authorization form.

We will not accept sunscreen that comes in an aerosol can. Numerous publications including the FDA and Consumer Reports have all stated that sunscreen in aerosol containers is dangerous for children because they can potentially inhale the chemicals, such as aluminum. Aluminum has been linked to Alzheimer's and other diseases. The spray sunscreen may also cause asthma or irritate the condition in children who already have it.

MCHL is requesting parents apply sunscreen in the morning. MCHL will re-apply sunscreen after 3:00 when the children are going outdoors for recess.
